Office of Sponsored Projects and Office of Procurement and Contracts Subrecipient Determination Checklist

Please Mark all applicable characteristics to determine the relationship between MSU and the Entity.

Subaward: an entity, usually but not limited to non-Federal entities, that receives a subaward from a pass-through entity to carry out part of a Federal award; but does not include an individual that is a beneficiary of such award. A subrecipient may also be a recipient of other Federal awards directly from a Federal awarding agency.

Subawards have the following characteristics:

| Involved in a significant portion of the scope of work of an MSU sponsored project.
| Responsibility for programmatic decision making.
| Uses funds to carry out program within the organization as opposed to providing goods and services for a program.
| Responsible for adhering to applicable program compliance requirements.
| Subaward PI may be a co-author on publications or seek patent protection for inventions.

Vendor: A dealer, distributor, merchant, or other seller providing goods or services that are required for the conduct of a research program.

Vendors have the following characteristics:
| Provides goods or services within normal business operations.
| Provides similar goods or services to many different purchases.
| Operates within competitive environments.
| Provides goods or services that are ancillary to the operation of the research project.
| Are not subject to monitoring or reporting requirements of prime agreement.

Consultant: An individual or company retained to provide professional advice or services on a project for a fee.

Consultants have the following characteristics:	
Company or individual who is a consultant (expert advisor) who pursues this line of busin him/herself.	ess fo
Paid for their time at a fixed rate (daily/hourly, etc).	
Consultant is considered "work for hire" thus all intellectual property and copyrightable information is assigned to MSU.	
Usually for a short period of time.	
RFP sometimes dictates the amount that can be charged.	
Based on the criteria above, the relationship with the entity should be considered a:
